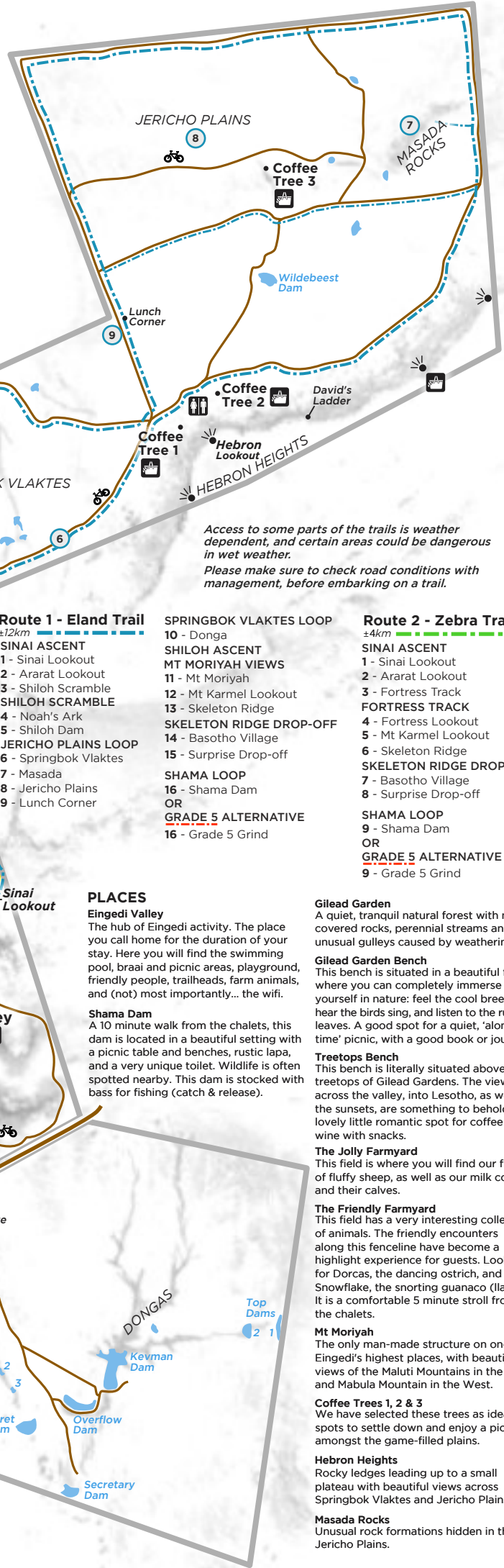
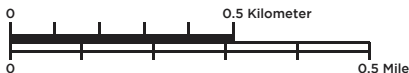

PLACES

Eingedi Valley

The hub of Eingedi activity. The place you call home for the duration of your stay. Here you will find the swimming pool, braai and picnic areas, playground, friendly people, trailheads, farm animals, and (not) most importantly... the wifi.

Shama Dam

A 10 minute walk from the chalets, this dam is located in a beautiful setting with a picnic table and benches, rustic lapa, and a very unique toilet. Wildlife is often spotted nearby. This dam is stocked with bass for fishing (catch & release).

Gilead Garden

A quiet, tranquil natural forest with moss-covered rocks, perennial streams and unusual gulleys caused by weathering.

Gilead Garden Bench

This bench is situated in a beautiful forest where you can completely immerse yourself in nature: feel the cool breeze, hear the birds sing, and listen to the rustling leaves. A good spot for a quiet, 'alone-time' picnic, with a good book or journal.

Treetops Bench

This bench is literally situated above the treetops of Gilead Gardens. The views across the valley, into Lesotho, as well as the sunsets, are something to behold. A lovely little romantic spot for coffee or wine with snacks.

The Jolly Farmyard

This field is where you will find our flock of fluffy sheep, as well as our milk cows and their calves.

The Friendly Farmyard

This field has a very interesting collection of animals. The friendly encounters along this fenceline have become a highlight experience for guests. Look out for Dorcas, the dancing ostrich, and Snowflake, the snorting guanaco (llama). It is a comfortable 5 minute stroll from the chalets.

Mt Moriyah

The only man-made structure on one of Eingedi's highest places, with beautiful views of the Maluti Mountains in the East and Mabuila Mountain in the West.

Coffee Trees 1, 2 & 3

We have selected these trees as ideal spots to settle down and enjoy a picnic amongst the game-filled plains.

Hebron Heights

Rocky ledges leading up to a small plateau with beautiful views across Springbok Vlaktes and Jericho Plains.

Masada Rocks

Unusual rock formations hidden in the Jericho Plains.
